Frequently Asked Questions by members:

What is procedure to plant trees?

Complete an Arc Form; identify placement location and type of tree.

What is the procedure for guests staying overnight?

All guests must register in guest book in the clubhouse or complete guest form upon arrival or before. Guests forms are available online under forms for members to complete and place in office slot. Members are responsible to inform guests of all Mariner's Cove rules (Association Documents)

Who can drive golf carts in Mariner's Cove?

No children under the age of 16 should be driving golf carts in Mariners Cove.

What children restrictions apply on common areas?

Adults must accompany all children at all times, on common ground areas.

What guest restrictions apply on common areas?

Members are responsible for their guests no matter what age when on common ground.

Are there restrictions about the shuffleboard courts?

Stay off the shuffleboard courts playing area. Sweeping of the court area before playing extends the life of the court. Children need adult supervision.

What are the restrictions on using the streets?

Roller blading/skating, skate boarding, etc. are not permitted. Bicyclists and golf carts drivers need to maintain safe operating speed. Speed limit is 10 miles an hour in Mariner's Cove.

Where can guest park?

Overnight parking is not allowed on common grounds without Board permission. Guest can park on your grass or property as long as it does not interfere with your neighbors having the ability to come and go from their unit. All overnight vehicles must be off the roads.

What are the pool rules?

Pool rules are posted at the pool. Please be kind when your precious ones are here by respecting all other Mariners Cove members. Please refrain them from splashing, jumping, screaming and running. We are 55+ community.

What is quiet time?

Our governing documents have a designated time that is called quiet time. That time is from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. Please respect your neighbors.
